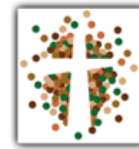

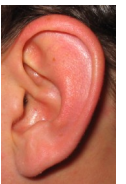
Service of Consecration - At our Worship Gathering

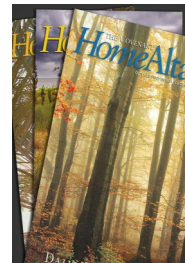
There will be No YOGA Classes on 2/21.
