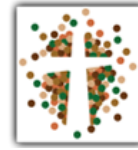

Giving Basics.

That's our Stewardship theme this year. In the church we often use words like "tithes" and phrases like, "Please prayerfully consider your pledge," but we don't really explain what they mean. 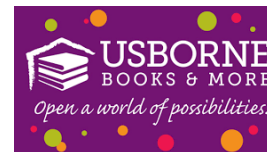
