Who is God? What is God like? What sorts of things does God do? What sorts of things does God value? What does God love?

As a church, God is always at the front and center of who we are, what we believe and how we live. There are many ways to talk about God and his

priorities, but one of the more helpful and fruitful ways is through God's titles and names. Listing the names, titles and descriptions of God helps us to firmly see the things God values and the way God manifests himself to us. We can know God through what God is called.

This Lent, as we use forty days to prepare for Easter, we are going to spend time in the Psalms with this very theme. The Psalms are the great poems and songs of the Bible, located right in the middle of it all! They use wonderful imagery and engaging phrases to shower praise and prayer to the Lord. We will be reading through these Psalms in the lead up to Easter and consider the theme: The Lord is Our _______. Each Sunday in worship we will "fill in the blank", using the theme of the Psalm and discover that the Lord is our rock, light, salvation, help, hiding place, restorer and cornerstone.

We also invite you to read Psalms each day during Lent. We will be providing a reading plan (see below); you can also sign up to have the passages emailed or texted to you each day. As you read, fill in the blank: The Psalm says the Lord is Our/My ______. Ponder what that means as you go through your day. At the end of your day, pray "Lord, I thank you that you are my/our _____...." In this way, the Psalms will guide our lives together during Lent and prepare our hearts for the great truth of Easter where we see that God is our Resurrection through Jesus Christ our Lord!





Save the Date!


